### HUMAN RIGHTS ACT 2001 (APPOINTED DAY) (No.1) ORDER 2001

*Laid before Tynwald* : 20th February, 2001

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by section 23(2) of the Human Rights Act 2001<sup>(a)</sup>, and all other enabling powers, the following Order is made :-

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Human Rights Act 2001 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2001.

#### **Appointed day**

2. The following provisions of the Human Rights Act 2001 shall come into operation on 1 March 2001 -
  - (a) section 1(4), (5) and (6);
  - (b) sections 13 and 14;
  - (c) section 17;
  - (d) section 18;
  - (e) section 19 but only to the extent necessary for the operation of the provisions brought into force by this Order; and
  - (f) section 23.
