

Reservoir Stocking during the Angling Season

Unless there are exceptional circumstances (** see below), the following reservoirs are stocked on a weekly basis throughout the fishing season:-

Clypse
Kerrowdhoo

Cringle
Ballure

The following reservoirs, due to their size, are generally stocked on a fortnightly basis:-

Sulby
West Baldwin

Eairy Dam is stocked on a weekly basis at the start of the season; however stocking may cease during the hotter summer months due to low water levels and excessive weed growth.

Times of stocking:

The actual days of stocking will often vary from week to week.

As a guide, only *Clypse* reservoir is closed completely for a period of time after stocking, however *Kerrowdhoo* is available as an alternative.

Baldwin, *Kerrowdhoo* and *Cringle* reservoirs have no-fish zones where fishing is prohibited for a period of time after stocking.

Sulby has a permanent no-fish zone in place.

Ballure currently is not being closed after stocking, but this is subject to change.

Closures zones are along the dam wall and upto the red markers at each reservoir.

Please pay close attention to the closure times on the notice boards shown at each reservoir.

** examples:-

- predatory birds on Ballure at the start of the fishing season
- stocking maybe restricted during TT and Manx Grand Prix periods
- low pH levels at start of season
- Isle of Man Water Authority maintenance and works
