Site Supervision: There is no permanent on-site supervision, however, Forestry staff and the Police periodically visit the Claddagh and weekend security patrols take place during peak periods of use. The Forestry Warden also visits from time to time and can be contacted on 07624 490714.

Toilets: The toilet block on the Claddagh is open from 16th March to 30th September and the toilet for the disabled is operated by a 'Radar' lock. At other times, the nearest toilets can be found in the Ballabrooie Estate which is situated half way along the Sulby Straight near to Glen Kella Distillery.

CAMPERS

Spacing: Campers must leave a 6m spacing between tents, campers and caravans.

Occupation: Please do not leave your camper van, caravan or tent unoccupied overnight.

Generators: Please be considerate in the use of generators. Switch them off when not required and at night to avoid disturbing other campers.

Children's Safety: Due to the existence of water hazards in the nearby river and in the interests of road safety, small children must be supervised by a responsible person at all times.

Neighbours: Please respect the privacy of neighbouring land owners. The land surrounding the Claddagh is private, please do not climb over fences or enter driveways.

Litter: Please take your litter home with you or use the bins provided. Please leave the site clean and tidy.

Dog Walkers: Please keep dogs under control at all times and do not allow them to wander. Pick up after them.
