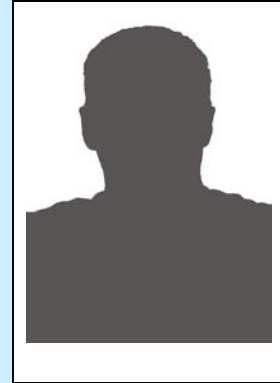

**Notes**

1. All entries must be made in the format shown and should be checked as being correct before submission to the Ship Registry. Any forms received with incorrect entries and/or information missing may lead to either the application being returned or a delay in processing the application.

2. Photographs and signatures must either be original or good scanned copies of an original, these must be placed within the boxes provided and must not exceed the size of the boxes. If a photograph or signature is deemed to be unacceptable this may lead to either the application being returned or a delay in processing the application.

3. Applications for Endorsements not made on this form will not be processed and will be returned without the issuance of a CRA.

4. In Sections 4 and 5 the 'Responsible Officer' is either a person from the Operators Crewing Department or from the Isle of Man Representative Person, it is not to be an Officer of the vessel the applicant is to serve on.

6. In the case of applications where an officer has previously held an endorsement issued by the Ship Registry a copy of that endorsement must be forwarded with the renewal application, if this is not provided it may lead to either the application being returned or a delay in processing the application.
