

CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT ACT 1975

**CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT (COURT OFFICERS, ETC.) (EXEMPTION) ORDER
1989**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 4 of the Control of Employment Act 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Employment (Court officers, etc.) (Exemption) order 1989 and, subject to section 4(2) of the Control of Employment Act 1975, shall come into operation on the day following its approval by Tynwald.

Exemption of court officers, etc.

2, The employment specified in the Schedule are exempted from the operation of the Control of Employment Act 1975

SCHEDULE

EXEMPTED EMPLOYMENTS

1. Employment as an acting Deemster.
2. Employment as a chairman or member of any commission, tribunal or inquiry established under a resolution of Tynwald or any enactment.
3. Employment as an inspector under any enactment to investigate and report on the affairs of any body corporate, partnership or individual.
4. Employment as an arbitrator for any specific arbitration proceedings which have been or may be commenced in the Island.
5. Employment as counsel or as a solicitor by or for any person who is a party to or directly affected by any specific proceedings which have been or may be commenced before a court, tribunal or arbitrator in the Island, where the employed person is not ordinarily resident in the Island.
6. Employment in any capacity in relation to any proceedings which have been or may be commenced before a court, tribunal or arbitrator in the Island, where the employed person is paid out of money provided by Tynwald.
7. Employment in any capacity to assist, or provide services for, the Attorney General or the Isle of Man Constabulary in relation to the investigation of fraud or any other crime.
8. Any other employment of a temporary nature in relation to any specific proceedings which have been or may be commenced before a court, tribunal or arbitrator in the Island, where the employed person is not ordinarily resident in the Island.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order exempts certain employments listed in the Schedule from the provisions of the Control of Employment Act 1975. This means that a work permit will not be required in those cases.

The listed employments relate primarily to those involved in the investigation of fraud and crime and the work of the criminal and civil courts.
