CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT ACT 1975

**CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT (NON-RESIDENT DIRECTORS) (EXEMPTION)
ORDER 1988**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 4(1) of the Control of Employment Act 1975 (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following order is hereby made:~

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Employment (Non-Resident Directors) (Exemption) order 1988 and, subject to section 4(2) of the Control of Employment Act 1975, shall come into operation on the 1st June 1988.

Exemption for non-resident directors

2. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) to (4), employment as a director (not being executive director) shall be exempt from the operation of the Control Employment Act 1975.
(2) The exemption provided by paragraph (1) shall apply only in respect employment in the Island in any 3 days in each calendar month.
(3) The exemption provided by paragraph (1) shall not apply if such director is ordinarily resident in the Island.

(4) In this article -

“director” means a director or similar officer of a body corporate (wherever incorporated);

“executive director” means a director who is required to devote a substantial part of his time to the service of the body corporate concerned in a managerial, administrative or technical capacity.
