THE CASINO (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1999

Approved by Tynwald

18th January 2000

Coming into operation

1st February 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Isle of Man Gaming Control Commissioners by section 11 of the Casino Act 1986¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made: —

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Casino (Amendment) Regulations 1999 and, subject to section 21 of the Casino Act 1986, shall come into operation on the 1st February 2000.

Amendment of the principal Regulations

2. (1) The Casino Regulations 1997² are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 10(1) (prescribed games), for "Poker Dice" substitute "Any game of dice".

(3) For regulation 20 (name) substitute —

"Name

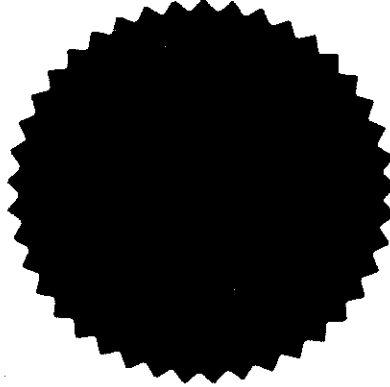
20. The casino operated at the premises known as the Hilton Hotel (formerly the Stakis Hotel) at Central Promenade, Douglas shall be called by the name Hilton Hotel & Casino."

(4) In regulation 22 (approval of casino staff) —

(a) omit paragraph (3); and

(b) in paragraph (6), omit the words in brackets.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Casino Regulations 1997. Any game of dice may be played at the Casino; the permitted name of the Casino is changed to "Hilton Hotel & Casino"; and the requirement for a certificate issued to a member of the Casino staff to be of a specified colour is abolished.
