GAMING (AMENDMENT) ACT 1984

CONTROLLED MACHINES (PRESCRIBED AMOUNTS) REGULATIONS 2009

Coming into operation

1st April 2009

The Isle of Man Gambling Supervision Commission makes these Regulations under section 1(4) and (5) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984¹.

1. Title and commencement

- (1) The title of these Regulations is the Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations 2009.
- (2) If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on the 1st April 2009

2. Prescribed amounts

- (1) The amounts prescribed for the purposes of section 1(4) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984 are —
 - (a) for the purpose of section 1(4)(a) (maximum charge for play)
—
 - (i) in the case of a quiz machine, £1;
 - (ii) in the case of a prize machine other than a quiz machine, 50p;
 - (iii) in any other case, £2;
 - (b) for the purpose of section 1(4)(c) (maximum prize) —
 - (i) in the case of a quiz machine, £50;
 - (ii) in any other case, £35.

- (2) In this regulation "quiz machine" has the meaning given by regulation 3(2) of the Controlled Machines Regulations 1985².

3. Revocation

The Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations 2007³ are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations specify the maximum stake and maximum prize for amusement machines. The amounts are unchanged, except that higher maxima are prescribed for "quiz machines".
