## AN ACT

to permit more than one public lottery in one year; to permit the sale of tickets or chances at any time of the year; to enable the price of tickets to be fixed by direction of the Treasury; to provide for the proceeds of public lotteries to be paid to the Public Lottery Trust or such other charitable purposes as may be specified in regulations; and for connected purposes.

**5 Interpretation**

In this Act-

'the 1981 Act' has the meaning given by section 1(1);

'Public Lottery Trust' means the charitable trust of that name registered under the Charities Registration Act 1989.

**6 Short title and commencement**

This Act may be cited as the Public Lotteries (Amendment) Act 1993 and shall come into operation on such day as the Treasury may by order prescribe.
