THE SUBMARINE CABLES ACT 2003

THE SUBMARINE CABLES (FEES) REGULATIONS 2004

Approved by Tynwald: 15 December 2004

Coming into operation: 28 January 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by section 10(2)(e) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to, the Submarine Cables Act 2003¹, and after consulting persons whom the Department of Transport considers will be thereby affected, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Submarine Cables (Fees) Regulations 2004 and, subject to section 10(4) of the Submarine Cables Act 2003, shall come into operation on the 28 January 2005.

2. Application for an authorisation

A fee of £18,000 shall be payable to the Department of Transport on the making of an application for an authorisation.

3. Inspection under the Safety Regulations

(1) A fee of £70 per hour shall be payable to the Department of Transport by the responsible person in respect of any inspection of cable works or the site of cable works carried out under regulation 4 of the Submarine Cables (Safety) Regulations 2004².

(2) In this regulation "cable works" and "the responsible person" have the same meanings as in those Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations prescribe an application fee of £18,000, payable to the Department of Transport on the making of an application for authorisation to lay a submarine cable in the territorial waters of the Isle of Man, and an inspection fee of £70 per hour for inspections of cable works carried out under the Submarine Cables (Safety) Regulations 2004.
