All Postal applications must be accompanied by a cheque or postal order and not cash.
Payment at the counters may be paid by: Cheque, Cash, Debit Cards or postal orders.

Place of Payment

The following vehicles will require the application to be made to the D.o.I., Sea Terminal Building or post to: D.o.I. Licensing Office, PO Box 363, Douglas, Isle of Man, IM99 3EZ.

- a. All vehicles over 7500kg without a reminder notice.
- b. Taxis
- c. Buses or minibuses
- d. Vehicles that have been written-off or seriously damaged and taken out of use but have been subsequently repaired.

All other applications will require to be handed in at the nearest Post Office or post to: Isle of Man Post Office, Licensing Agent, PO Box 367, Douglas, Isle of Man, IM99 3HA.

Dishonoured Cheques.

If a cheque for a licence is dishonoured, the licence will be void from the date of issue and the vehicle will become unlicensed.

Vehicles requiring Certificates from Vehicle Test Centre Tromode.

- a. Hire and Drive vehicles over 3 years old.
- b. Taxis.
- c. Buses or minibuses over 6 months old (category D and D1 whether or not they are used to carry passengers for hire or reward). If the vehicle is to be used for carrying passengers for hire or reward a certificate of initial fitness is also required.
- d. Vehicles previously licensed in the Isle of Man and which have had no licence in the last 2 years.
- e. Vehicles that have been scrapped, written-off or seriously damaged and taken out of use but have been subsequently repaired.
- f. A goods vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of 3,500kg.

If a certificate is required, please book the vehicle into the Test Centre at least 1 month prior to expiry of your present licence.

Insurance Certificate.

A valid Insurance Certificate is required.

If the goods vehicle is not used commercially to carry or haul goods

Vehicles in categories B & B1, registered on the Isle of Man, on or after the 1st April 2010 are liable to be licensed on their CO₂ emissions. Emissions data can be found on the V55 or V5 registration documents. Other documented proof confirming emission data may be supplied by the manufacturer at the time of registration. Information obtained from the internet will not be accepted.		
If the supplied documentation contains CO₂ emissions data, then the vehicle must be registered and licensed according to the following emissions bands -
