

What to do when a British passport holder dies

Please fill in this form if a British passport holder has recently died. For security purposes, please cut off the top right-hand corner of the passport before sending it to us. This is to stop the passport being used fraudulently.

If you've already used the Tell Us Once service, you don't need to fill in this form as Her Majesty's Passport Office has already been notified. You can only use the Tell Us Once service if you know the holder's passport number. If the passport is lost or not available, you will need to fill in this form and send us an original copy of the death certificate. We'll send the certificate back to you after we've cancelled the passport on our system.
