Request for information from the Isle of Man Courts and Tribunals (General Registry)

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2015 every person who is resident on the Isle of Man has a legally enforceable right to obtain access to information held by a public authority, subject to certain exemptions and practical refusal reasons.

This form should not be used for requesting personal information about yourself, as this cannot be provided under the Freedom of Information Act 2015. These requests should be made under the Data Protection Act 2002 as a Subject Access Request.

Please note that under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2015; **'Court Information'** is absolutely exempt information. Note: Various provisions do exist (primarily for parties to a given case) to enable access (on application to the relevant Court or Tribunal etc.) to certain court information where appropriate.
