Road Transport Licensing Committee Monthly Newsletter GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Copies of all applications are available at the RTLC office.

Within a period of 21 days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. They should be sent to the applicant's registered address as well as to the RTLC office. APPLICATIONS

AAA Construction Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register one goods vehicle under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as Highcliffe, Ramsey Road, Laxey, IM4 7PD and the proposed operating centre is listed as Ballacreggan Farm, Old Castletown Road, Douglas.

Planning approval or a certificate of lawfulness may be required for the operating centre.

2. Farmers Combine Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register three goods vehicles under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as 20-21 West Quay, Ramsey, IM8 1DL and the proposed operating centre is listed as Unit 244, Jurby Industrial Estate, Jurby.

Planning approval or a certificate of lawfulness may be required for the operating centre.

3. Costain's Scrap Metal Merchants Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register three goods vehicles under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address and the proposed operating centre is listed in the application as The Scrap Yard, Main Road, Foxdale.

The applicant does not need to obtain planning approval for the operating centre.

4. Ramsey Town Commissioners

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register four goods vehicles under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as Town Hall, Parliament Square, Ramsey, IM8 1RT and the proposed operating centre is listed as Riverside Workshops, Poylldooey Road, Ramsey.

The applicant does not need to obtain planning approval for the operating centre.

5. Kissack Bros Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register fifteen goods vehicles along with one trailer under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as Flat 2, Crosby House, Main Road, Crosby, IM4 4BP and the proposed operating centre is listed as Rose Villa, Kissacks Lane, Crosby.

Planning approval or a certificate of lawfulness may be required for the operating centre.

6. Transmann Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register five goods vehicles along with two trailers under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address and the proposed operating centre is identified in the application as The Second Milestone, Peel Road, Braddan.

Planning approval or a certificate of lawfulness may be required for the operating centre.

7. J. Qualtrough & Co. Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register five goods vehicles under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as Hope Street, Castletown, IM9 1AN and the two proposed operating centres are listed as;

- Hope Street, Castletown.
- Hills Meadow, Douglas.

The applicant does not need to obtain planning approval for either operating centre.

8. Corlett Building Materials Ltd.

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and register twenty goods vehicles under the Road Transport Regulations 2018.

The applicant's registered address is identified in their application as Ballaharra Quarry, Peel Road, St. John's, IM4 3RB and the three proposed operating centres are listed as;

- Ballaharra Quarry, St. John's.
- Ballacross Farm, Poortown Road, Peel.
- The Tile Plant, Mill Road, Peel.

Planning approval or a certificate of lawfulness may be required for Ballacross Farm. The applicant does not need to obtain planning approval for the other centres.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next scheduled RTLC meetings for goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently scheduled to take place on Thursday 14th March, Thursday 11th April and Thursday 9th May at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is anticipated that most of the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at the March meeting.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
