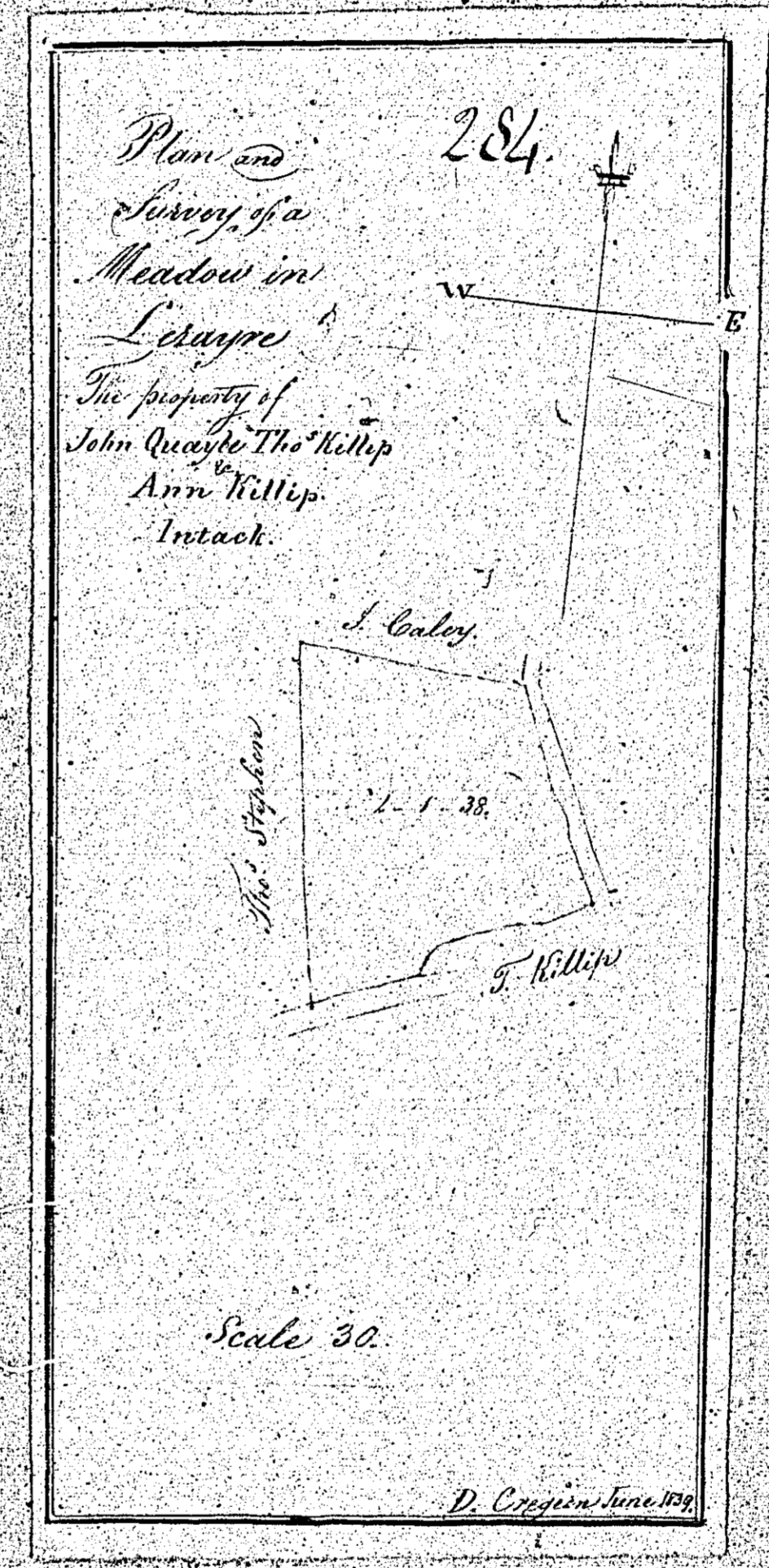
TITHE PLANS: PARISH OF LEZAYRE
