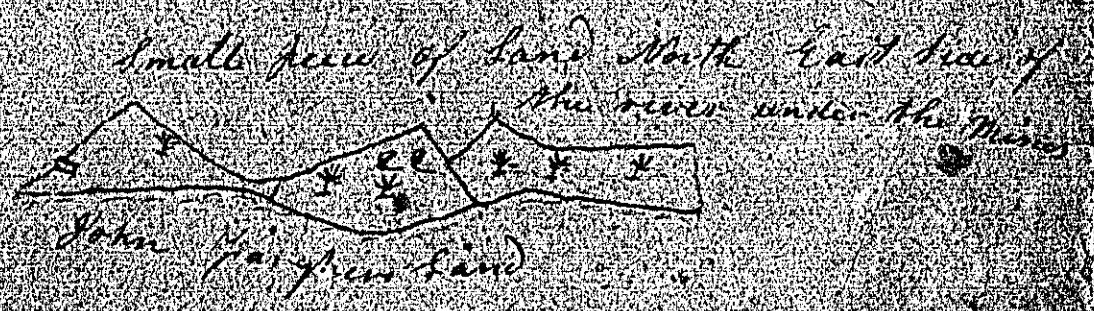
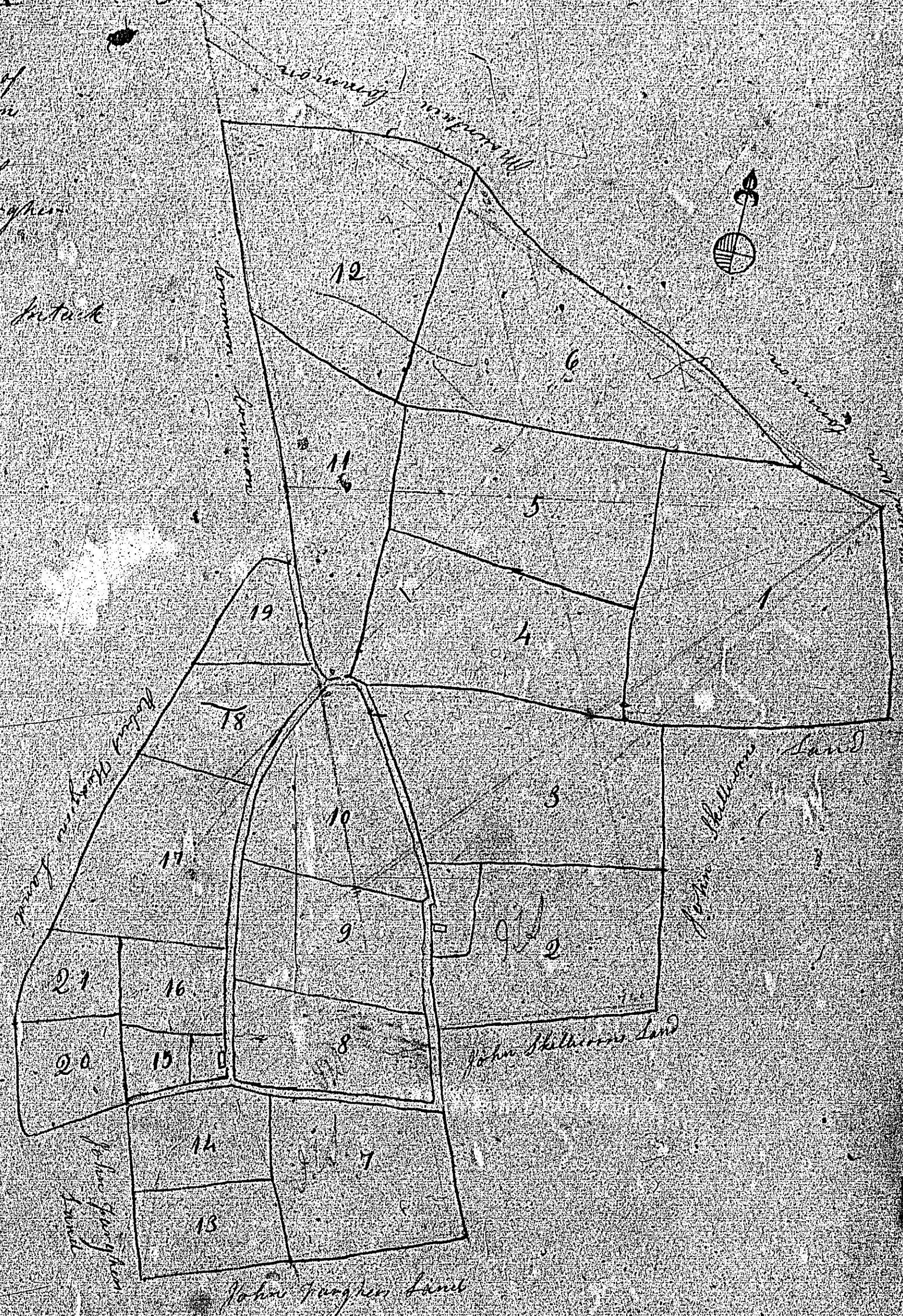

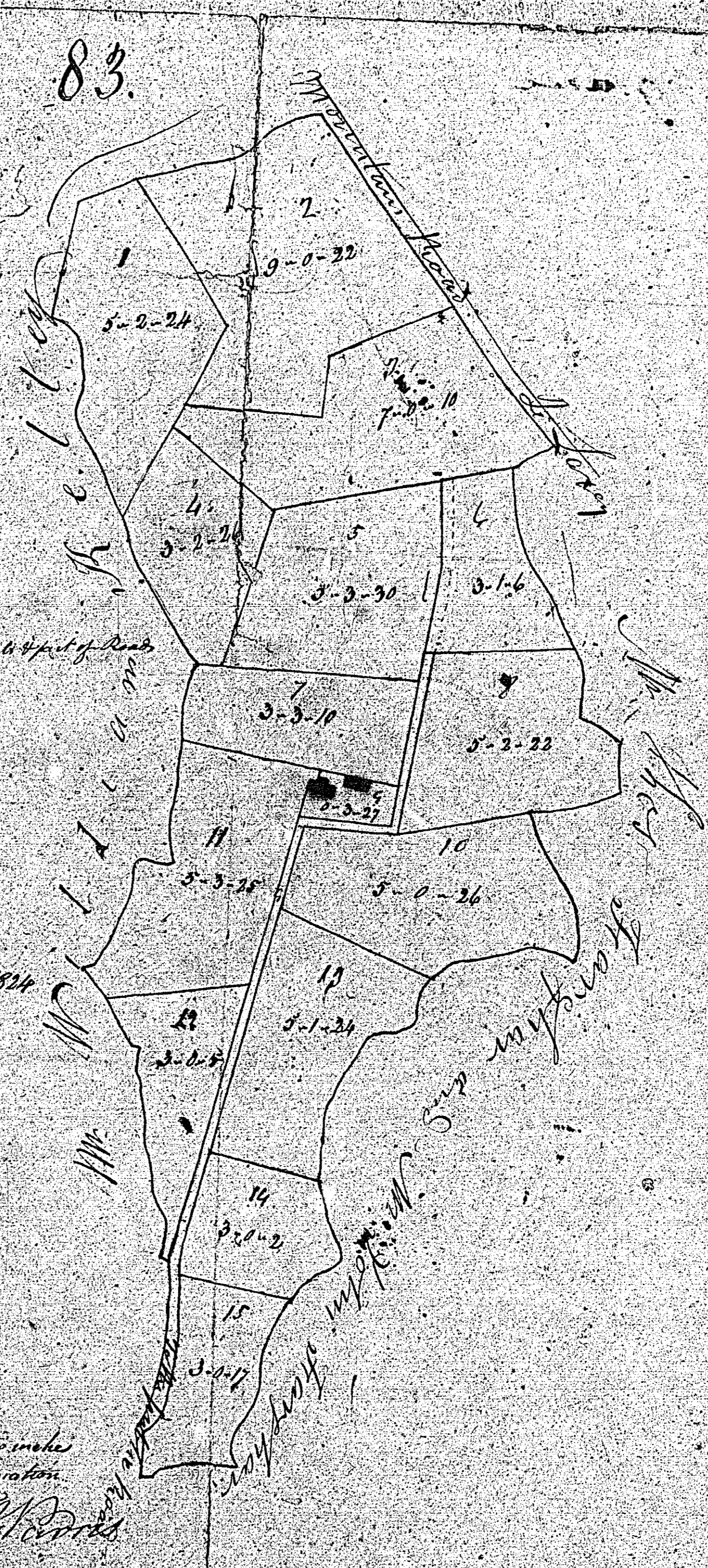

Scale of Chains

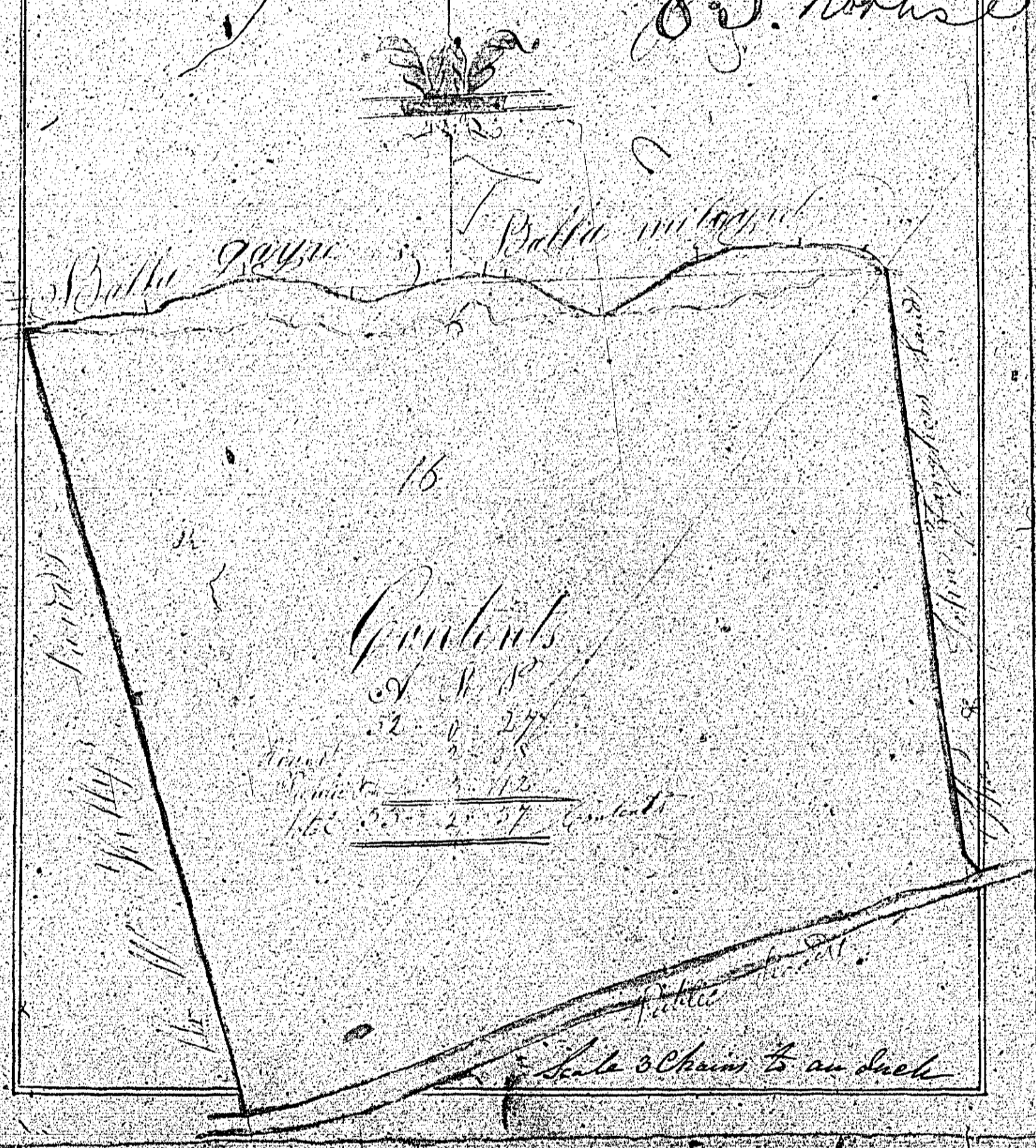


The above scale of 9 Chains is the same as the scale of 4 Irish inches on which this plan is formed.



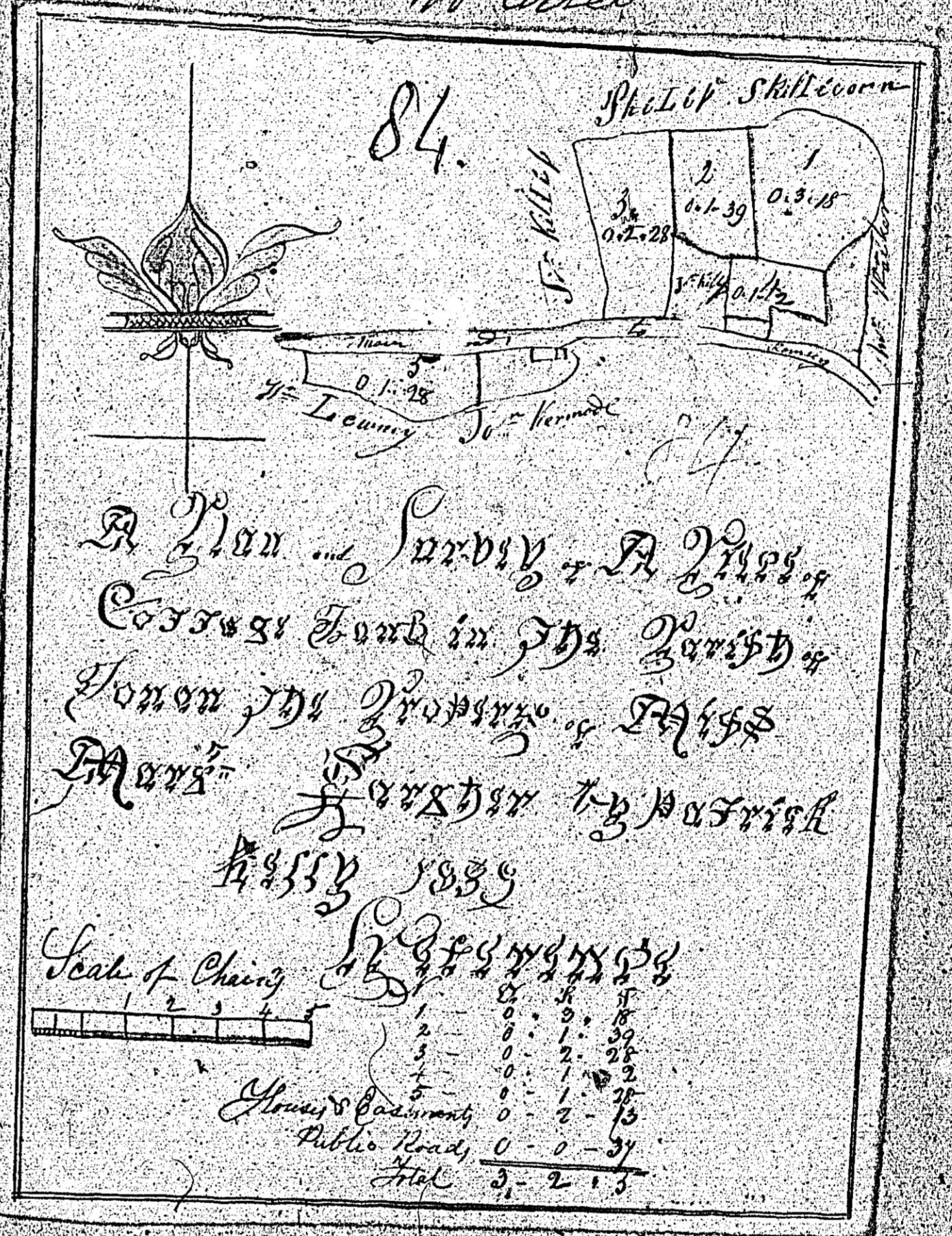
