The Survey Section was established in December 1997 to provide Land Survey services for Highway and Structural Design Engineers. The benefits of in-house surveying were quickly realised through availability, technical advice and commitment.

Surveys are carried out to a very high standard using a Land Survey Specification based on RICS Guidelines. Modern one person robotic equipment is used, with the level of survey detail and finished product format tailored to client requirement.

Each survey is coordinated to National Grid Transformation OSTN15 and levelled to Ordnance GNSS Datum (Douglas02) to facilitate overlaying on the Island Digital Mapping and Orthophotography.

Volumetric and Section analysis is carried out with specialised survey software.

Land Survey services are currently utilised by Divisions in the Department of Infrastructure; including Airports, Highways, Harbours, Properties, Civil Engineering, Quarries and Architects. The Water and Sewerage Authority is also a regular client. In addition, updates to the Island Digital Mapping are surveyed, which the Isle of Man Registry incorporates into its CLARE system.

Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS) surveying is used extensively for many tasks, including establishing Survey Control. The surveyors maintain a growing list of Control Stations, details of which can be obtained using the contact details above.
