### GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

#### Notice Period

The Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC” or “the Committee”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Copies of all applications are available at the RTLC office.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. ## APPLICATIONS

### 1. Island Aggregates Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate 14 goods vehicles.

The applicant’s registered address is identified in the application as Island Aggregates Limited, Island House, Isle of Man Business Park, Douglas and the four proposed operating centres are identified as:

- Santon Concrete, Oatlands Quarry, Santon
- Foxdale Concrete, Stoney Mountain Road, Foxdale
- Jurby Concrete, Jurby Industrial Estate, Jurby
- Point of Ayre Quarry, Cranstal, Bride
