Complete this form if your former employer

- · Has become insolvent or has ceased to trade on the Isle of Man, and
- Failed to give you proper statutory notice to terminate your employment.

Statutory notice is

- · One week's notice if your employment lasted for at least 1 month but less than 2 years, or
- One week's notice for each complete year of employment if it lasts for 2 years or more up to a maximum of 12 weeks.

Make your claim for compensation at the end of your statutory notice period. For this purpose, take your notice period as starting on the day after you were given notice, or if you were not given notice, the day after you were dismissed.
