GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC” or “the Committee”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Copies of all applications are available at the RTLC office.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full RTLC Procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website; www.gov.im/rtlc.

APPLICATIONS

1. Island Tree and Landscaping Services Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate three goods vehicles.

The applicant’s registered address and proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Ballavilley, The Dhoor, Lezayre.

The applicant has indicated that they have planning approval for the operating centre.

2. TNC Plant Hire Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate four goods vehicles.

The applicant’s registered address and proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Matrix House, Parkway, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant has indicated that they have planning approval for the operating centre.

3. Ellan Vannin Fuels

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate four goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address and proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 4A, Portside, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant has indicated that they have planning approval for the operating centre.

12. JDW Engineering Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate three goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Close Veg, Glen Darragh Road, Glen Vine and the two proposed operating centres are identified as:

- Eilerslie Depot, Old Church Road, Crosby
- JDW Engineering Ltd, Glen Darragh Road, Glen Vine

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the Eilerslie Depot operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999. The applicant has indicated that it has a certificate of lawfulness of use or development for the JDW Engineering Ltd operating centre.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next meetings of the Committee which will be held in public are currently scheduled to take place on 17th October, 24th October and 7th November at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

It is hoped that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at the 7th November meeting. All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.

If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
