GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC” or “the Committee”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Copies of all applications are available at the RTLC office.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full RTLC Procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website; www.gov.im/rtlc.

APPLICATIONS

1. Manx Textile Recycling Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant’s registered address is identified in the application as Manx Textile Recycling Ltd, Glen Mona House, Glen Mona, Maughold and the proposed operating centre is identified as Sandown Lodge, Kinnea Estate, St Johns.

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

2. Event Lighting Services Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant’s registered address and proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 7, Cronkbourne Business Park, Braddan.

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

3. SGL Construction Ltd

- DOI Jurby Hangar, Jurby Industrial Estate, Jurby Road, Jurby (maximum of 12 goods vehicles)
- DOI Onchan Butt, Church Road, Onchan (maximum of three goods vehicles)
- DHSC Ramsey and District Cottage Hospital, Cumberland Road, Ramsey (maximum of four goods vehicles)
- DESC Ramsey Grammar School, Crossag Lane, Ramsey (maximum of two goods vehicles)
- DOI Ramsey Ship Yard Depot, Ship Yard Road, Ramsey (maximum of two goods vehicles)
- DEFA Thie Slieau William, Foxdale Road, St Johns (maximum of four goods vehicles)
- Vehicle Test Centre, Ballafletcher Road, Tromode, Douglas (maximum of six goods vehicles)
- DEFA Animal Waste Processing Plant, Richmond Hill, Douglas (maximum of four goods vehicles)
- DOI Highways Department, Andreas Depot, A17 Bride Road, Andreas (maximum of eight goods vehicles)
- DOI Ballasalla Depot, Bridge Road, Ballasalla (maximum of 12 goods vehicles)

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

5. Kennaugh & Skinner Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate two goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Kennaugh & Skinner Ltd, The Workshop, Athol Place, Port Erin and the proposed operating centre is identified as Athol Place, Port Erin.

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

6. Malew Parish Commissioners

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate five goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Commissioners Office, Main Road, Ballasalla and the two proposed operating centres are identified as:
