GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Regulations 2018 (“the 2018 Regulations”) require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTALC” or “the Committee”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Copies of all applications are available at the RTALC office.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full RTALC Procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTALC website; www.gov.im/rtlc.

APPLICATIONS

1. EG Services Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant’s registered address is identified in the application as 1 Albert Square, Ramsey and the proposed operating centre is identified as Ardonan Nurseries, Regaby, Andreas.

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

2. Gary Davenport Plant Hire Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant’s registered address and proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Boodeys Cottage, Foxdale Road, Garth, Crosby.

No designated Transport Manager has been nominated in the application and so the applicant will rely on the three year period of grace, as detailed in the 2018 Regulations, as the time period in which it must nominate a qualified Transport Manager.

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

6. Middle Park Metals

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration to operate four goods vehicles and two trailers.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Ballacutchel Farm, Mount Murray, Braddan and the proposed operating centres are identified as:

- Ballacutchel Farm, Mount Murray, Braddan (maximum of 20 goods vehicles and two trailers).

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

8. KPC Construction & Groundworks
