ADVICE TO RHEUMATOLOGY PATIENTS

REQUESTING INFORMATION ON THEIR MEDICATIONS IN VIEW OF CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

- 1. Avoid contact with people with respiratory/other infections, flu-like illnesses or children/adults with contagious illnesses.
- 2. Avoid any trips abroad which are not necessary.
- 3. Avoid events/places with large numbers of people.
- 4. Do not visit people in hospital or elderly persons in care homes.
- 5. Follow good hand hygiene and avoid touching face.
- Continue rheumatological DMARD therapy unless advised not to take it – this should not be discontinued if patients do not have any symptoms of infection.
- 7. If you have any flu-like symptoms, cough, temperature, self-isolate and stop medication PLEASE ADVISE THE RHEUMATOLOGY TEAM IF YOU STOP YOUR MEDICATION OR HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO STOP YOUR MEDICATION BY THE GP OR THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT.
- 8. Please ensure that your vaccinations as per the black box on your clinic letters are up-to-date.
