GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTALC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

NOTICES

Emergency Powers Resulting from the Covid-19 Pandemic

As you may already be aware, the Lieutenant Governor signed a proclamation on Monday 29th June revoking the state of emergency. As a result of this the regulations governing the suspension of the RTALC fell away. This includes the temporary relaxation of Regular Safety Inspections for licensed/registered operators, which must now return to the agreed conditions on your operator licence/registration.

All of the powers that were delegated to DEFA have now returned to the RTALC.

APPLICATIONS

1. G. J. Ingham & Sons Limited

To vary the Operator Registration through a change of registered office address.

The applicant’s new registered office address is identified in the application as Old Gas Works Office, Mill Road, Peel.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

2. R. G. W. Limited

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as John Willie & Co Ltd, Begoade Moar Farm, Onchan. The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The application was approved.

5. J Nicholson t/a Nicholson Haulage

To apply for an Operator Registration to operate three goods vehicles and three trailers.

The applicant's registered address was identified as Kimmeragh Lodge/Farm, Bride and the proposed operating centre was identified as East Kimmeragh Farm, Bride.

The application was approved.

6. Marks and Spencer

To apply for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered addresses were identified as 7 Drumgold Street, Douglas and M&S Group plc, Waterside House, 35 North Wharf Road, London. The proposed operating centre was identified as M&S Kirby Warehouse, Unit 8, Kirby Farm Industrial Estate, Vicarage Road, Braddan.

The application was approved.

7. JMD Plant Hire Ltd

To apply for an Operator Registration to operate six goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address was identified as Ballacutchel Farm, Mount Murray, Braddan and the three proposed operating centres were identified as:

The application was approved.

To apply to vary an Operator Licence through the addition of one trailer.

The proposed operating centre was identified as Unit 4, Parkway, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next scheduled meetings of the Committee for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently scheduled to take place on 19th August 2020 and 3rd September 2020 at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is anticipated that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of these two meetings.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTAL office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTAL staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
