### GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

#### Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTALC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

## APPLICATIONS

### 1. Manx Utilities Authority

To vary the Operator Licence through the addition of 15 goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 45 goods vehicles and 2 trailers.

### 2. Manx Utilities Authority

To vary the Operator Licence through the addition of seven operating centres.

The proposed operating centres were identified as:

- MUA Laxey Primary Substation, Minorca Hill, Laxey (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- MUA Castletown Primary Substation, Main Road, Castletown (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- Ballakissack Beg, School Lane, Santon (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- Ballalough Farm, Poortown Road, Peel (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- Trollaby Farm, Trollaby Lane, Union Mills (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- Cronk Chronnee, Braaid Road, St. Marks (maximum of one goods vehicle)
- Ballachrink Lodge, East Baldwin (maximum of one goods vehicle)

The applicant will need to obtain evidence that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 45 goods vehicles and 2 trailers.

3. Chris Clarke Ltd t/a Garden World

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Garden World Yard, Tromode Road, Douglas.

This is the applicant's existing operating centre but evidence that it is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 it still outstanding.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles.

4. CCJ Group Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 2, Tromode Estate, Tromode.

This is the applicant's existing operating centre but evidence that it is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 it still outstanding.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

5. Island Tree and Landscaping Services Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Ballavilley, The Dhoor.

This is the applicant's existing operating centre but evidence that it is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 it still outstanding.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles.

6. Manx Utilities Authority

To vary the Operator Licence through a change in the maximum number of vehicles to be kept at their Meary Veg operating centre from 11 goods vehicles and one trailer to 19 goods vehicles and one trailer.

The applicant will have to obtain evidence that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 for the increased number of vehicles.

## **DECISIONS**

1. G. J. Ingham & Sons Limited

To vary the Operator Registration through a change of registered address.

The applicant's new registered office address is identified in the application as Old Gas Works Office, Mill Road, Peel.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

**The application was approved.**

2. R. G. W. Limited

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as John Willie & Co Ltd, Begoade Moar Farm, Onchan.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

**The application was approved.**

Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
