The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the RTLC making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

## **RTLC Office Procedures Resulting From COVID-19 Pandemic**

From 00:01 on Thursday January 7<sup>th</sup> 2021 the Isle of Man moved into a three week circuit-break lockdown to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

As a result the public counter at Thie Slieau Whallian is now closed to the public and all appointments have been cancelled for the foreseeable future.

#### **Review of Fare Meter Tariff**

The RTLC may from time to time determine the **maximum** fares to be charged by vehicles when under hire as per Section 35 of the Act.

In accordance with the Public Passenger Vehicles (Fares and Fare-Meters) Regulations 2002, the RTLC may review such fares and invite consultation or representation by interested parties.

A review of the tariff was started in February 2020 with a deadline for submissions of March 17<sup>th</sup> 2020 but, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this review was never taken forward.

The RTLC is hereby giving notice of a new review of the current fares given that circumstances have changed since February 2020. All Operators, Representative Bodies and any other interested stakeholders are invited to submit their views along with any fare proposals by **Friday February 19**<sup>th</sup> **2021**.

The RTLC will then consider all representations at a meeting to be held in February or March with a view to issuing a notice regarding any proposed changes to the tariffs shortly thereafter.

All views or proposals should be sent to the attention of the Secretary at the RTLC Office.

## **List of Representative Bodies**

The Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the RTLC to publish in a Circular, from time to time, a list specifying the name and address of every Representative Body in accordance with Sections 11 and 26 of the Act.

The initial list of Representative Bodies was issued in AD&N Circular No: 1 dated 15<sup>th</sup> March 2002.

The RTLC would like all Representative Bodies on the above list to confirm that their names and addresses are still correct or detail any necessary amendments. All correspondence should be addressed to the RTLC Secretary.

The RTLC also invites expressions of interest from any organisations that wish to notify it that they would like to be considered as a Representative Body. Please note that a Representative Body is defined in Section 63 of the Act as, "a body appearing to the Committee to be representative of passenger vehicle operators, or of any class of such operators".

Please note that any Representative Bodies, and any organisation that would like to be considered as a Representative Body, will need to confirm the appropriate details to the RTLC office by **Friday February 5<sup>th</sup> 2021**.

## **New Goods Vehicle Inspector**

I am pleased to announce that the RTLC has appointed a Goods Vehicle Inspector. While his primary focus will be Goods Vehicles, from time to time he will also assist the PPV Inspector in duties such as inspecting maintenance records and visiting operating centres.
