

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

If you wish to view an application, please contact the RTLC Secretary at noel.capewell@gov.im.

Copies of all monthly newsletters are available on the RTLC website: www.gov.im/rtlc.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the RTLC making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

RTLC Office Procedures Following End of January Lockdown

Now that the January circuit-break lockdown has been lifted the public counter at Thie Slieau Whallian is now open.

Any appointments that had to be cancelled during the lockdown are now being rearranged.

Even though the public counter is open, you are strongly recommended to make an appointment in advance if you wish to visit the RTLC office. If you do not do this then your journey could be wasted as there may be no RTLC staff members available to assist you when you arrive.

Renewal of Operator Discs

There is no need for Ply for Hire and Private Hire operators to come into the RTLC office to renew a vehicle's annual operator disc if you do not want to. As long as you can take a picture of your most recent test pass certificate from the Vehicle Test Centre and email it to rtlc@gov.im, we can call you when it is convenient to take payment over the phone using a debit card or credit card. The disc can then be posted out to you.

Alternatively, copies of the pass certificates can be posted to the RTLC office or scanned and sent via email. Please do not put an original pass certificate in the post.

If you still wish to come into the RTLC office to renew an operator disc, please make an appointment in advance.

Reminder about Review of Fare Meter Tariff

In AD&N Circular No. 521 PPV operators were invited to submit their views along with any fare proposals as part of a review of the fare meter tariff.

Driver Badges

In AD&N Circular No. 513 it was announced that the RTLC had received a number of requests from drivers and operators to remove names from PPV driver badges and that such a move would be in line with PPV identification badges in many other jurisdictions. The AD&N asked for any comments, reservations or objections to be sent to the RTLC office. None were received.

As a result, all driver badges will now be issued without names as in the below example:



Existing badges that have the names of drivers on them will continue to be valid (as long as they have not passed the expiry date).

Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
