GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLCL”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLCL website.

APPLICATIONS

1. J Clawson Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary their Operator Registration through a change in operator name and through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The proposed new operator name is J Clawson Scaffolding Ltd.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application but evidence is still required that the applicant’s existing operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

2. Green Valley Farm Supplies Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Licence and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant’s registered address is identified in the application as Wetfields, Ballagawne Road, Baldrine and the proposed operating centre is identified as Ballacoar Farm, Ballagawne Road, Baldrine.

The applicant has indicated that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

3. Paul Cassidy

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 4 Bayr ny Grianagh, Castletown and the proposed operating centre is identified as Unit 1, Billown Farm, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

4. GRC Metals Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address and the proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 267, Jurby Industrial Estate, Jurby.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

5. Legg Surfacing Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 39 Auldyn Meadow Drive, Ramsey and the proposed operating centre is identified as Colas, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

6. T. C. Q. Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary their Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application but evidence is still required that the applicant's existing operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles.

7. Marlinspike Properties Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate two goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Burleigh Manor, Peel Road, Douglas and the proposed operating centre is identified as Units 15 and 16, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

8. Manx Utilities Authority

The applicant wishes to vary their Operator Licence through an increase in the number of goods vehicles to be kept at one of their operating centres.

The existing operating centre is identified in the application as Castletown Primary Sub Station, Malew Road, Castletown and it is proposed that the number of goods vehicles to be kept at this operating centre will be increased from one to six.

Evidence is still required that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

9. XPO Supply Chain UK Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Licence and operate five goods vehicles and four trailers.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Saltire Court, Castle Terrace, Edinburgh and the proposed operating centre is identified as Manx Co-operative Ltd, Unit 20, White Hoe Industrial Estate, Old Castletown Road, Douglas.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

10. Environmental Techniques Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Licence and operate three goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 3 Flush Park, Knockmore Road, Lisburn and the proposed operating centre is identified as Unit 7, Parkway, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

If the application is approved, the new Operator Licence will replace their existing Registration.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

DECISIONS

1. Manx Telecom Trading Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through a change in director/responsible officer.

The application was approved.

2. Island Express Ltd

To vary the Operator Licence through the addition of three goods vehicles. No new operating centres were identified in the application.

The application was approved.

3. Dandara Homes Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle. No new operating centres were identified in the application.

The application was approved.

4. R Cain Plant Hire Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

No new operating centres were identified in the application but evidence is still required that the applicant's existing operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The application was approved.

RTLCL MEETINGS

Due to the current lockdown, it is not known when the next scheduled meeting of the RTLCL will take place.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.
