GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

APPLICATIONS

1. T. C. Q. Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application but authorisation from the Planning Section at the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture (“Planning”) is still required that the applicant’s existing operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate six goods vehicles.

2. Island Civils and Plant Limited

To apply for an Operator Registration and permission to operate two goods vehicles.

The applicant’s registered address is identified in the application as 1 Close Corlett, Peel and the proposed operating centre is identified as Ballaquaggan Farm, Douglas Road, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain authorisation from Planning that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

3. Creer Contracting

To vary the Operator Licence through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application and the applicant has already received authorisation from Planning that its existing operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

4. Hersham Electrical Engineers Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration by reducing the frequency of regular safety inspections.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application and the applicant has already received authorisation from Planning that its existing operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

DECISIONS

1. XPO Supply Chain Limited

To apply for an Operator Licence and permission to operate five goods vehicles along with four trailers.

The applicant's registered address was identified in the application as Saltire Court, Castle Terrace, Edinburgh and the proposed operating centre was identified as Manx Co-operative Ltd, Unit 20, White Hoe Industrial Estate, Old Castletown Road, Douglas.

The application was approved.

2. T. C. Q. Ltd

To vary the Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

3. Marlinspike Properties Ltd

To apply for an Operator Registration and permission to operate two goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address was identified in the application as Burleigh Manor, Peel Road, Douglas and the proposed operating centre was identified as Units 15 and 16, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The application was approved.

4. Manx Utilities Authority

To vary an Operator Licence by allowing an increase in the number of goods vehicles kept at an operating centre.

The operating centre was identified in the application as Castletown Primary Sub Station, Malew Road, Castletown and it was proposed that the applicant would keep six goods vehicles at this operating centre.

The application was approved.

5. J Clawson Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle and a name change of the operator.

The proposed new operator name is J Clawson Scaffolding Ltd.

Both parts of the application were approved.

6. Gary Davenport Plant Hire Ltd

To apply for an Operator Registration and permission to operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address and proposed operating centre was identified in the application as Boodeys Cottage, Foxdale Road, Garth, Crosby.

The application was approved.

RTLIC MEETINGS

The next scheduled meeting of the Committee for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently scheduled to take place on 17th June, 28th July and 25th August 2021 at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

Please be aware that all applicants for new Operator Registrations or Licences will be required to obtain full authorisation for their operating centres from Planning before the applications can be considered by the Committee.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at one of these three meetings.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLIC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLIC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
