## APPLICATIONS

### 1. XPO Supply Chain Limited

To vary an Operator Licence through the addition of one goods vehicle and one trailer.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles and four trailers.

### 2. Jones Services Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate nine goods vehicles.

### 3. MAP Groundworks Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

### 4. Easymix Concrete Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of three goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

5. Legg Surfacing Ltd

An application for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle was originally advertised in GV AD&N 22.

This application has yet to be approved, but the applicant has decided to apply for a different operating centre than the one that was advertised in GV AD&N 22. The new operating centre has been identified by the applicant as Unit 9, The Paddocks, Jurby.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 39 Auldyn Meadow Drive, Ramsey.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

6. Island Fuels Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 4 Bayr ny Grianagh, Castletown and the proposed operating centre is identified as Unit C 6/7, Balderton Court, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

7. Green Valley Farm Supplies Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Wetfields, Ballagawne Road, Baldrine and the proposed operating centre is identified as Ballacoar Farm, Ballagawne Road, Baldrine.

Should the application be approved, the applicant's existing Operator Licence will be surrendered.

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant has approval under its current Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle.

8. Mezeron Limited

To vary an Operator Registration through a change in operator name to WS Mezeron Ltd.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate seven goods vehicles and 18 trailers.

9. Chardaid Developments Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as The Auburns, 19 Lezayre Road, Ramsey and the proposed operating centre is identified as Unit 6, Clock Tower Industrial Estate, Foxdale.

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

10. MSN Roofing and Scaffolding Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

11. Absolute Scaffolding Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate nine goods vehicles.

12. Douglas Borough Council

Should the application be approved, the applicant's existing Operator Licence will be surrendered.

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

The applicant has approval under its current Operator Registration to operate 22 goods vehicles.

13. Costains Scrap Metal Merchants Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

14. Fox Brothers (Lancashire) Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate six goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as Unit 2, Olympic Court, Whitehills Business Park, Blackpool and the proposed operating centres are identified as Lagan Site, Gate 8A, Site Compound, Balthane Road, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

Please be aware that all applicants for new Operator Registrations or Licences will be required to obtain full authorisation for their operating centres from Planning before the applications can be considered by the Committee.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at either the 25<sup>th</sup> August or 22<sup>nd</sup> September meetings.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLIC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLIC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
