Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

APPLICATIONS

1. Mr MP Harkot – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part “A” of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through the addition of one Class A – Modern Style Executive Private Hire car.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as a rented car park space at Trinity Church, Bucks Road, Douglas. An assurance from the Planning Section at the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture (“Planning”) regarding the suitability of the proposed centre will not be required.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi (wheelchair accessible) in the East and Malew Districts.

2. Mr S Osman – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part “A” of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through a change of the applicant’s registered address and the addition of an operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as 15 Ayre View, Bride. An assurance from Planning will not be required.

Should the application be successful, the applicant will be surrendering 128 Maghergarran, Port Erin as an operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts.

3. Mr SA Williams – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

4. Mr V Ivanov and Mr S Vlakenski – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

5. Mr SM Campion – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through the addition of an operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as Hope Street car park, Castletown. An assurance from Planning may be required.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the Malew District and one Class A – Modern Style Executive Private Hire car.

6. Mr S Hesketh – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through a change of the applicant's registered address and the addition of an operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as 39 Howe Road, Onchan. An assurance from Planning will not be required.

Should the application be successful, the applicant will be surrendering 3 Mourne View Road, Peel as an operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the Malew District.

7. Ms P Noble – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through the addition of one Section 29 service of Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District, following the transfer of business under the provisions of the Road Transport Regulations 2018, from the previous operator Mr B Maxwell.

The operating centre is identified in the application as 20 Fuchsia Lane, Douglas. An assurance from Planning will not be required.

DECISIONS

1. Mr I Maule – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through the addition of two East District Ply for Hire Service licences to the applicant's existing two Malew District Ply for Hire Service licences.

The application was refused.

2. Mr P Storry – Operator Registration Variation

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through a change of registered address and the addition of an operating centre.

The operating centre was identified in the application as 11 Hillcroft, Douglas.

7 Seaview Road, Onchan has been surrendered as an operating centre.

The application was approved.

3. Mr P Forrest – Application for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To replace a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The application was approved.

4. Mr GC Thwaites – Application for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To replace a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The application was approved.

5. Mr J Speight – Application for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To replace a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of two Ply for Hire taxis in the East District.

The application was approved.

6. Mr MP Harkot – Application for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To replace a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East and Malew Districts (wheelchair accessible).

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the Committee for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 25th August and 29th September 2021 at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of these two meetings.

This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
