GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

APPLICATIONS

1. NK Construction Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

2. Slade Scaffolding Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address is identified in the application as The Stables, Fort Anne Road, Douglas. The proposed operating centre is identified in the application as Ballacamine Farm, Ballacorey Road, Bride.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

3. N Callow and Sons Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of three goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

4. Paddleman Ltd t/a Askbuck Recycling

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

5. XPO Supply Chain UK Limited

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Licence through a change in operator name to GXO Logistics UK Limited.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate six goods vehicles and five trailers.

6. Department of Infrastructure

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in Director / Responsible Officer.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 100 goods vehicles and three trailers.

7. Mann Waste Recycling Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles.

The registered address and proposed operating centre are identified in the application as Unit 1-4, WC, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

8. Island Civils and Plant Limited

An application for an Operator Registration to operate one goods vehicle was originally advertised in GV AD&N 23.

This application has yet to be approved, but the applicant has decided to apply for a different number of vehicles and trailers than the number advertised in GV AD&N 23. The applicant wishes to apply to operate five goods vehicles and two trailers.

The applicant's registered address is identified in the application as 1 Close Corlett, Peel and the operating centre is identified as Ballaquaggan Farm, Douglas Road, Ballasalla.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

1. XPO Supply Chain UK Limited

To vary an Operator Licence through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

2. Jones Services Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

3. MAP Groundworks Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

4. Easymix Concrete Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of three goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

5. Hersham Electrical Engineers Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the reduction in the frequency of regular safety inspections.

The application was approved.

6. Mezeron Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through a change in operator name to WS Mezeron Ltd.

The application was approved.

7. MSN Roofing and Scaffolding Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

8. Absolute Scaffolding Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

9. Costains Scrap Metal Merchants Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

10. Douglas Borough Council

To apply for an Operator Registration to replace their Operator Licence and operate 22 goods vehicles.

The applicant's registered address was identified as Town Hall, PO Box 2, Douglas and the proposed operating centres were identified as:

- Operational Service Centre, Isle of Man Business Park, Barley Field Road, Braddan, and
- Ballaughton Nurseries, Harcroft Meadows, Douglas

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999. The applicant has surrendered CA Site, Middle River, Douglas as an operating centre.

The application was approved.

RTLIC MEETINGS

The next scheduled meetings of the Committee for goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently scheduled to take place on 29th September and 20th October 2021 at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

Please be aware that all applicants for new Operator Registrations or Licences will be required to obtain full authorisation for their operating centres from Planning before the applications can be considered by the Committee.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at either of these meetings.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLIC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLIC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
