GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee (“the RTLC”) to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to the application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

NOTICES

Section 75 of the Road Transport Regulations 2018 (“the Regulations”) confirms that existing licensed goods vehicle operators have three years in which to obtain “relevant certificate of professional competence qualifications.” This notice is to remind all Goods Vehicle Operator Licence holders that the three-year period expires on **1st January 2022**. Any licensed operator that has not obtained a certificate of professional competence (“CPC”) by this date will be committing an offence under Section 8 of the Road Transport Act 2001 and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £5,000. They will also not be able to continue to operate.

If you are a licensed operator and you are concerned that you will not have obtained a CPC by 1st January 2022, you are strongly advised to contact the RTLC office as soon as possible.

APPLICATIONS

1. Robinsons

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles.

2. Douglas Borough Council

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change of Transport Manager.

The new Transport Manager is listed in the application as Mr Iain Jackson. Once the application has been disposed of Mr A Crook will no longer be a responsible officer of the applicant.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 22 goods vehicles.

3. Freight Hub Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles and three trailers.

The registered address is identified in the application as 15 The Crescent, Douglas and the proposed operating centre is identified as Cringle Quarry, Ronague.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

4. Isle of Man Meat Company Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address and the proposed operating centre is identified in the application as The Meat Plant, Ballafletcher Farm Road, Tromode.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

Should the application be successful, the applicant will be surrendering its Operator Licence.

The applicant has approval under its current Operator Licence to operate three goods vehicles.

DECISIONS

1. NK Construction Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

2. N Callow and Sons Ltd

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of three goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

3. Paddleman Ltd t/a Askbuck Recycling

To vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

4. XPO Supply Chain UK Limited

To vary an Operator Licence through a change in operator name to GXO Logistics UK Limited.

The application was approved.

5. Department of Infrastructure

To vary an Operator Registration through a change in Director / Responsible Officer.

The application was deferred.

RTLCL MEETINGS

The next meeting of the Committee for goods vehicles which will be held in public is scheduled to take place on 24th November 2021 at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

Please be aware that all applicants for new Operator Registrations or Licences will be required to obtain full authorisation for their operating centres from Planning and, in the case of Goods Vehicle Operator Licence applications, confirm that a representative of their operation has a CPC qualification before their applications can be considered by the Committee.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at the meeting on 24th November.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLCL office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLCL staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
