GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

APPLICATIONS

1. AAA Construction Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

2. Paul Carey & Sons Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate six goods vehicles and two trailers.

3. Organic Construction Solutions

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address and proposed operating centre are identified in the application as Unit 5, Springham Park, Spring Valley Industrial Estate, Douglas.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before the application can be approved.

4. Portland Services Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in registered address from Millennium House, Victoria Road, Douglas to 15 Peel Road, Douglas.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

5. Department of Infrastructure

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of seven operating centres.

The new operating centres identified in this application are:

- Battery Pier Depot, South Quay, Douglas (10 vehicles)
- Strathallan Horse Tram Depot, Strathallan Crescent, Douglas (4 vehicles)
- Laxey Depot, Glen Road, Laxey (2 vehicles)
- Ballakinnish Depot, New Castletown Road, Douglas (20 vehicles)
- Plant Depot, East Baldwin Road, East Baldwin (4 vehicles)
- Hillberry Depot, A18, Douglas (8 vehicles)

As an existing operator, the applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before 1st January 2024.

Should the application be successful, the applicant will be surrendering the following three operating centres:

- Ramsey and District Cottage Hospital, Cumberland Road, Ramsey
- Ramsey Grammar School, Crossag Lane, Ramsey
- Vehicle Test Centre, Ballafletcher Road, Tromode, Douglas

The applicant currently has approval to operate 100 goods vehicles and three trailers.

6. R & A Services

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles.

The registered address and proposed operating centre are identified in the application as Skerrisdale, Stockfield Road, Kirk Michael.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before the application can be approved.

7. Easymix Concrete Limited

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in registered address from Apartment 6, 11-12 Peel Road, Douglas to 5 Bayr Grianagh, Castletown.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at the meeting on 29th March 2022.
