The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the RTLC making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

1. Mr GR Cowell – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

2. Mr SH Cross – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

3. Mrs A Cowin – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

4. Mr JF Thompson – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

5. Mr GG Rees – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles by combining the applicant's previously separate Ply for Hire service licences to operate in the East District and the Malew District onto the same Ply for Hire plate. This will result in the same vehicle being allowed to operate in both Districts but there will be no overall increase in the number of service licences in use.

The registered address and operating centre is identified in the application as 26 Laurel Avenue, Onchan. This is already an authorised operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District and one Ply for Hire taxi in the Malew District.

6. Ms SM Holt and Mr AJ Ramsay – Variation of Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through a change in the name of the registration following the marriage of one of the joint operators.

The new name of the registration would be "Mrs SM Harrington and Mr AJ Ramsay".

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

7. Mr Paul Joughin – Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence

To apply for a Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence on expiry, through the provision of two Ply for Hire taxis in the East District.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two Ply for Hire taxis in the East District, one Class A – Modern Style Executive Private Hire car and one Private Hire minibus.

8. Mr BS Hesketh – New Operator Registration

To apply as a new operator under Part "A" of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles through the addition of one Section 29 Ply for Hire vehicle of up to eight passenger seats in the East District (wheelchair accessible), following the transfer of business under the provisions of the Road Transport Regulations 2018, from the previous operator Mr JC Stevens.

The registered address and operating centre is identified in the application as 1 Thirlmere Avenue, Onchan. This is already an authorised operating centre.

RTLC MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 29th March, 7th April and 21st April at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of the April meetings provided that the RTLC has all the information that it needs (e.g. assurances from Planning).

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
