



GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTALC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTALC website.

APPLICATIONS

1. Manx Steel Services Ltd t/a Firewood and Forestry

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles.

The registered address and proposed operating centre are identified in the application as Ballacrye Farm, Main Road, Ballaugh.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before the application can be approved.

2. Geoff Cormode Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate four goods vehicles.

3. Dandara Homes Limited

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle and through a change in the frequency of regular safety inspections from eight weeks to 13 weeks.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles.

4. Graylaw International

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in Transport Manager.

The new Transport Manager is listed in the application as Mr Steve Walton. Should the application be successful, Mr Andrew White will no longer be a responsible officer of the applicant.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 16 goods vehicles.

5. Manx Gas Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

While there are no new operating centres identified in this application, the maximum number of vehicles to be kept at the Princess Alexandra Pier, Douglas operating centre will be increased from two to three goods vehicles.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles.

6. Brendan Downey Construction Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as 21 Lheannag Park, Douglas and the proposed operating centre is identified as 29 Phase E, Middle Park, Middle Farm, Braddan.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before the application can be approved.

7. Kinrade Bros. Haulage Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of one goods vehicle.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate four goods vehicles.

1. Manx Telecom Trading Ltd

To vary an Operator Licence through the addition of an operating centre.

The application was approved.

It is likely that the applications advertised in this AD&N Circular which are eligible to be considered by the Committee will be heard at the meeting on 21st April 2022.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
