



## GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

### Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

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## APPLICATIONS

### 1. Castlebay Seafoods Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of two goods vehicles.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

### 2. Hitchens (Removal and Storage) Ltd

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address and proposed operating centre are identified in the application as Unit 4, Clock Tower Industrial Estate, Foxdale.

The applicant has obtained confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 before the application can be approved.

Should the application be successful, the applicant will be surrendering its Operator Licence.

The applicant has approval under its current Operator Licence to operate two goods vehicles.

### 3. GE White Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change in Transport Manager from Mr A Campbell to Mr D Gough.

Should the application be successful, Mr A Campbell will no longer be a responsible officer of the applicant.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

4. Callister Removals Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Licence through a change in Transport Manager from Mrs G Seville to Mr R Callister.

Should the application be successful, Mrs G Seville will no longer be a responsible officer of the applicant.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles and one trailer.

5. Douglas Borough Council

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Licence through the addition of an operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application is Douglas Borough Lawn Cemetery, Johnny Watterson Lane, Douglas.

The applicant has received confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.
