GOODS VEHICLES APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

Notice Period

The Road Transport Act 2001 and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the Committee" or "the RTLC") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

Within a period of twenty one days from the date of this publication, any person may write to the Committee making any objections or representations with respect to an application.

Written objections can be received by letter or email. They should include the name and address of the sender and include the reasons why the objection or representation is made. For the full procedure detailing the submission of objections please see the RTLC website.

RTLC Office

The RTLC office operates on an appointment only basis. If you come to the office without an appointment you may have a wasted journey as there might not be anyone available to assist you.

RTLC OFFICE CLOSURES

The RTLC office will be closed on 5th October, 20th October and 21st October.

The licensing system currently used by the RTLC office is no longer fully supported by the company that created it. As a result, the RTLC office is moving to a new system and all office staff will need to undergo training on the new system on these days.

APPLICATIONS

1. TCQ Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two further goods vehicles. There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate seven goods vehicles.

2. TG Plant Services Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two further goods vehicles and the addition of an operating centre.

GV AD&N Circular No: 35 - 4th October 2022

The operating centre is identified in the application as Unit 267, Jurby Industrial Estate, Jurby. The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

As the operator submitted its original application for an Operator Registration before 1st February 2020, it has until 31st December 2023 to confirm that all operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 as per regulation 75(4) of the Road Transport Regulations 2018 ("the 2018 Regulations").

The applicant currently has approval to operate one goods vehicle.

3. <u>Department of Infrastructure</u>

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Registration through a change of registered address and the addition of an operating centre.

The new registered address is identified in the application as Ellerslie Depot, Old Church Road, Crosby.

The operating centre is identified as Isle of Man Prison, St. Patrick's Close, Coast Road, Jurby. The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

As the operator submitted its original application for an Operator Registration before 1st February 2020, it has until 31st December 2023 to confirm that all operating centres are compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999 as per regulation 75(4) of the 2018 Regulations.

The applicant currently has approval to operate 100 goods vehicles and three trailers.

4. Ace Hire & Sales Ltd

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Licence through a change of Transport Manager from Mr F Miles to Mr E Crowe.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate two goods vehicles.

5. Jamie's Removals Limited

The applicant wishes to vary an Operator Licence through a change of registered address from 33 Broogh Wyllin, Kirk Michael to 27 Raad Roagan, Peel.

There are no new operating centres identified in this application.

The applicant currently has approval to operate five goods vehicles and six trailers.

6. Freight Hub Limited

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration and operate three goods vehicles and three trailers.

The registered address is identified in the application as 15 The Crescent, Douglas and the proposed operating centre is identified as Smithy Sawmill & Works, Rose Villa, Crosby.

The applicant will need to obtain confirmation that the operating centre is compliant with the Town and Country Planning Act 1999.

DECISIONS

1. Castlebay Seafoods Ltd

To apply for a variation to an Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two further goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

2. Hitchens (Removal & Storage) Ltd

To apply for an Operator Registration and the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address and the proposed operating centre were identified in the application as Unit 4, Clock Tower Industrial Estate, Foxdale.

The application was approved.

3. Manx Construction & Groundworks Ltd

To apply for an Operator Registration and the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address was identified in the application as 18 Highcroft Avenue, Douglas and the proposed operating centre was identified as Upper Ballachrink Farm, Ballasalla.

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for public passenger and goods vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 25th October and 29th November at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

All applicants and objectors that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting. It is likely, although not guaranteed, that applications advertised in this AD&N Circular will be heard at one of the above meetings provided that the RTLC has all the information that it needs (e.g. assurances from Planning).

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting. This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
