



APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

The Road Transport Act 2001 ("the Act") and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

OBJECTIONS

The Act provides for the RTLC to consider objections to applications in certain circumstances. Any person considering submitting an objection should first read the "Note on the submission by members of the public of objections to applications made to the RTLC" ("the Note") which is published in the "Downloadable Documents" section on front page of the RTLC website here.

The Note sets out the procedure for submitting an objection, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections. Please be aware that the RTLC has no power to consider objections outside of the circumstances outlined in the Note.

RTLC OFFICE

The RTLC office operates on an appointment only basis. If you come to the office without an appointment you may have a wasted journey as there might not be anyone available to assist you.

NOTICES

OPERATING CENTRES - TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1999 ("the 1999 Act") AND ROAD TRANSPORT REGULATIONS 2018

The RTLC continues to remind all existing operators that the period of grace to ensure that all operating centres comply with the above legislation expired on 31st December 2023.

It is therefore important to recognise that, from 1st January 2024, operators whose operating centres do not comply with the 1999 Act cannot legally operate any goods vehicles with a maximum laden weight of over 3,500kg. Should any operators choose not to comply with this they would be committing an offence.

APPLICATIONS

1. Robert Jones t/a Swept Clean Road Sweeping Services – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration through the right to operate five goods vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as 7 Glen View Apartments, Minorca Hill, Laxey and the operating centre is identified as Lynbrae, Baldhoon Road, Laxey.

The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

2. Macs Builders Merchants Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address is identified in the application as Main Road, St Johns.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application. The applicant may need to obtain confirmation that it is permitted to keep the goods vehicle applied for in the application at its existing operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles.

3. Callister Removals Ltd – Variation of an Operator Licence

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address is identified in the application as Unit 4, Parkway, Balthane, Ballasalla.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application. The applicant may need to obtain confirmation that it is permitted to keep the goods vehicle applied for in the application at its existing operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three goods vehicles and one trailer.

4. Tesco Distribution Limited – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for an Operator Registration through the right to operate nine goods vehicles and four trailers.

The registered address is identified in the application as Tesco House, Shire Park, Kestrel Way, Welwyn Garden City and the operating centre is identified as Tesco Distribution, Pulrose Road, Douglas.

The applicant confirmation that the operating centre in the application complies with the 1999 Act.

5. R Cain Plant Hire Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through a change in operating centre.

The new operating centre is identified in the application as Wilson & Collins Building Units 11 & 12, Balthane Estate, Ballasalla. The applicant has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

Should the application be successful, the operating will surrender Billown Farm, Malew as a registered operating centre.

The applicant currently has approval to operate six goods vehicles.

6. Gary Davenport Plant Hire Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address is identified in the application as Boodeys Cottage, Foxdale Road, Garth, Crosby.

There are no new operating centres identified in the application. The applicant may need to obtain confirmation that it is permitted to keep the goods vehicle applied for in the application at its existing operating centre.

DECISIONS

1. Paul Carey & Sons Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate three goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

2. NK Construction Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to vary its Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The application was approved.

3. Orrisdale Livestock Ltd – New Operator Registration

To register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

4. Manx Utilities Authority – Variation of an Operator Licence

To vary its Operator Licence through the addition of the right to operate 15 goods vehicles.

The application was approved.

5. Hesketh Investments Ltd – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary its Operator Registration through a change in operating centre.

The application was approved.

COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTLC for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 23rd January, 13th February and 27th February at The Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

The applications listed in this AD&N are likely to be heard at the 13th February meeting as long as the RTLC has all of the information that it requires (e.g. assurances from Planning). All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTLC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTLC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting.

This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
