

Reasons for Registration

The Castle Arms (The Glue Pot), Castletown, is included in the Protected Buildings Register for the following reasons:

ARCHITECTURAL INTEREST:

- Dating from at least the mid-19th century, the property retains elements of historic fabric and much of its historic form including its distinctive curved external wall detailing and double piled pitched roof. The property's basement may include evidence or elements of a defensive outwork called the 'New Worke', part of the enhancements constructed during the 17th century.

HISTORIC INTEREST:

- Initially constructed as a dwelling for the gaoler of the castle, and later converted as an Ale House for use by the Garrison of the Castle, the property helps to illustrate parts of the social, economic and military history of Castletown and the Castle itself.
