Who should apply using this form?

This application form should only be completed by individuals who are already in the Isle of Man and who are seeking to make an application for permission to stay under the Ukraine Extension Scheme.

Application types

Appendix U: Ukraine Scheme sets out the requirements for permission to stay under the Ukraine Extension Scheme. Any applicant must meet the criteria of the relevant section of Appendix U: Ukraine Scheme.

Ukraine Extension Scheme

An application for permission to stay under the Ukraine Extension Scheme **must be made on or before 16th May 2024.**

An applicant must have had permission to enter or stay in the Isle of Man on or between 18th March 2022 and 16th November 2023 (but the permission does not need to cover the whole of that period) unless,

- they had permission to enter or stay in the Isle of Man immediately before 1st January 2022 but that permission has since expired; or
- they are a child born in the Isle of Man to a parent who qualifies under the Extension Scheme.
- they are a child born in the Isle of Man or UK to a parent who was granted permission under Appendix Ukraine after 16th November 2023.
