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APPLICATIONS, DECISIONS AND NOTICES

The Road Transport Act 2001 ("the Act") and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

OBJECTIONS

The Act provides for the RTLC to consider objections to applications in certain circumstances. Any person considering submitting an objection should first read the "Note on the submission by members of the public of objections to applications made to the RTLC" ("the Note") which is published in the "Downloadable Documents" section on front page of the [RTLC website](http://www.gov.im/rtlc).

The Note sets out the procedure for submitting an objection, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections. Please be aware that the RTLC has no power to consider objections outside of the circumstances outlined in the Note.

RTLC OFFICE

The RTLC office operates on an **appointment only basis**. If you come to the office without an appointment you may have a wasted journey as there might not be anyone available to assist you.

NOTICES

RTLC OFFICE CLOSED

The RTLC office at Thie Slieau Whallian will be closed on 5th February 2024 due to a re-organisation of the office space by the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture. There will be no RTLC officers in the building that day.

OPERATOR DISCS EXPIRING IN MARCH

Reminder letters have been sent out to all operators with operator discs for public passenger vehicles ("PPVs") that expire in March. I would strongly recommend that operators contact the RTLC office and make an appointment to come in to obtain new discs in advance of the expiry date of the current disc.

If your annual test is due in March, you can make an appointment to get a new disc in advance of the test as long as you send us a copy of the test certificate once your vehicle has passed.

APPLICATIONS

1. PT Bell – New Section 29 Ply for Hire Service Licence (“S29 Licence”)

To apply for a S29 licence through the provision of three Ply for Hire taxis in the East District.

The registered address of the operator is 1 Christian Road, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate three Ply for Hire taxis in the East District and three Private Hire minibuses.

Any potential objectors should refer to the “Objections” section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

2. J Bell – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The registered address of the operator is 1 Christian Road, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

Any potential objectors should refer to the “Objections” section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

3. JE Kilic – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The registered address is identified in the application as 2 South View, Queens Promenade, Douglas.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District and one Private Hire car.

Any potential objectors should refer to the “Objections” section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

4. ET Frost – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary the operator registration of the applicant by moving from Part “B” of the Register of Public Passenger Vehicles (“PPVs”) to Part “A”. The applicant would also like to add the right to operate one Private Hire car.

The registered address is identified in the application as 19 Manor Park, Onchan. The operating centre is identified in the application as 9 The Crescent, Derbyhaven. An assurance from the Planning Section at the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture (“Planning”) will not be required.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Private Hire car.

Any potential objectors should refer to the “Objections” section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections.

5. L Joyce – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary the Operator Registration of the applicant through the addition of two operating centres.

The new operating centres are identified in the application as;

- 10 Slieau Ree Apartments, Union Mills.
- 45 High Street, Port St Mary.

An assurance from Planning will not be required for any of the centres.

The registered address of the operator is 24 Cronk View Crescent, Ballakilley.

The applicant currently has approval to operate one Ply for Hire taxi in the South and Malew Districts, one ply for hire taxi in the East District and one Private Hire car.

Any potential objectors should refer to the "Objections" section on page 1 of this AD&N Circular for information on the correct procedure for making objections, including the circumstances in which the RTALC is able to consider objections.

DECISIONS

1. L Joyce – Variation of an Operator Registration

To vary the Operator Registration of the applicant through the addition of an operating centre.

The new operating centre was identified in the application as 10 Knock Rushen, Castletown. An assurance from Planning was not be required.

The application was withdrawn.

2. KA Gogov – New S29 Licence

To apply for a S29 licence which would replace the existing licence on expiry, through the provision of one Ply for Hire taxi in the East District.

The application was approved.

RTLC MEETINGS

The next regularly scheduled meetings of the RTALC for public passenger vehicles which will be held in public are currently due to take place on 13th February and 27th February at Thie Slieau Whallian, Foxdale Road, St John's.

The applications listed in this AD&N are likely to be heard at the 27th February meeting as long as the RTALC has all of the information that it requires (e.g. assurances from Planning). All individuals that are required to attend a meeting will receive a formal invitation letter prior to the meeting.

Should you require information on the timetables for any upcoming meetings, please contact the RTALC office. If you intend to observe any meeting in public that you are not specifically invited to, it would be appreciated if you could inform RTALC staff of your intentions prior to the meeting.

This information is required to ensure that there is sufficient space at the meeting to accommodate any observers. Should there not be sufficient space at Thie Slieau Whallian, a different venue for the meeting would have to be found and this could delay proceedings.
