The Road Transport Act 2001 ("the Act") and the Road Transport Regulations 2018 require the Road Transport Licensing Committee ("the RTLC" or "the Committee") to publish details of applications, meetings and decisions.

### OBJECTIONS

The Act provides for the RTLC to consider objections to applications in certain circumstances. Any person considering submitting an objection should first read the "Note on the submission by members of the public of objections to applications made to the RTLC" ("the Note") which is published in the "Downloadable Documents" section on front page of the [RTLC website](http://www.gov.im/rtlc).

The Note sets out the procedure for submitting an objection, including the circumstances in which the RTLC is able to consider objections. Please be aware that the RTLC has no power to consider objections outside of the circumstances outlined in the Note.

## NOTICES

### OPERATING CENTRES - TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1999 ("the 1999 Act") AND ROAD TRANSPORT REGULATIONS 2018

The RTLC continues to remind all existing operators that the period of grace to ensure that all operating centres comply with the above legislation expired on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023.

It is therefore important to recognise that, from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, operators whose operating centres do not comply with the 1999 Act cannot legally operate any goods vehicles with a maximum laden weight of over 3,500kg. Should any operators choose not to comply with this they would be committing an offence.

## APPLICATIONS

### 1. JP Corry Group Ltd – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to register as a new operator through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as Stark Building Materials UK Limited, Tollbar House, Tollbar Way, Hedge End, Southampton and the operating centre is identified as JP Corry Group Ltd, Lezayre Road, Ramsey.

The operator has obtained confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

2. Mann Link Distribution Limited – New Operator Licence

The applicant wishes to apply for a new Operator Licence through the addition of the right to operate three goods vehicles and four trailers.

The registered address is identified in the application as 27 Raad Roagan, Peel and the operating centre is identified as Unit 4B, Portway, Balthane Industrial Estate, Ballasalla.

The operator has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

3. Telios SFO DMCC Limited – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for a new Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate one goods vehicle.

The registered address is identified in the application as 17 Cronk Drine, Union Mills and the operating centre is identified as Unit 15, Braddan Bridge Industrial Park, Peel Road, Braddan.

The operator has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

4. Rhys Cormode General Gardening Limited – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for a new Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate four goods vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as 1 Cooil Veg, Andreas and the operating centre is identified as Andreas Airfield, Andreas.

The operator has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.

5. KNR Construction Ltd – New Operator Registration

The applicant wishes to apply for a new Operator Registration through the addition of the right to operate two goods vehicles.

The registered address is identified in the application as 19 Westminster Terrace, Douglas and the operating centre is identified as Ballachrink Farm, Ballanicholas, Garth Road, Braaid.

The operator has yet to obtain confirmation that its operating centre complies with the 1999 Act.
