About this document:

<u>Use</u>: as an aid to complying with the record keeping requirements of the above Legislation.

Legislation Requirements:

Details of all sheep and goats moved, sold, re-identified and deaths must be recorded within 36 hours of the event.

The flock/herdmark and individual number must be recorded to identify and trace sheep or goats traded.

Keepers are required to hold <u>additional</u> records detailing year of birth and the month of identification (for sheep born after 1st Jan 2012).

All records, (paper, electronic or otherwise) must be made available to a Department Officer upon request.

Sheep and Goat records must be retained for at least six years.

Please note: for movements of large consignments, copies of Export Health Certificate / FMA intake schedule or electronic records may be held, providing these are cross-referenced in the movement book.

General Notes:

Sheep moved from a holding are required to be marked with appropriate eartag(s) bearing the flockmark of birth or residence, together with an individual identity mark, depending on age (see overleaf).

Additional Information:

On or before 4th June each year the total number of sheep and/or goats on a holding on the 4th May in that year shall be recorded as a separate entry in the movement book.
