

Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Warnings: Strong winds developing later.

Synopsis: Complex area of low pressure northwest of Ireland, slowly tracking east. **Wind:** South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 this evening, then veering west

overnight. Further veering northwest and increasing 5 or 6 in the north and east of

the area tomorrow afternoon.

State of Sea: Slight or moderate.
Weather: Isolated showers.
Visibility: Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: West or northwest 4 or 5, but 5 or 6 in the north and east of the area, becoming

northwest 5 or 6 in all waters overnight into Thursday, occasionally reaching 7 in

places Thursday afternoon.

State of Sea: Slight or moderate, becoming moderate occasionally rough Thursday afternoon.

Weather: Isolated showers. **Visibility:** Moderate or good.
