## What to do with a passport when the passport holder dies

It is important that the passport of the deceased is cancelled. For security purposes, please cut off the top right hand corner of the passport before returning it to us. This is to ensure the passport cannot be used fraudulently.

You should send the passport with this form to: Customer Service Manager, Customer Contact Centre, Her Majesty's Passport Office, PO Box 175, Nexus House, Mission Court, Newport NP20 2DW.
