## The fee

The current specified fee for applications on form SET(F) for Child or Adopted Child under the age of 18 of a parent, parents or a relative present and settled in the Isle of Man is **£2,389**.

Applications as the child or adopted child of a settled person in the Isle of Man must not include further dependants.

You must pay by one of the following methods:

- Cheque - made payable to 'Isle of Man Government'
- Postal Order - made payable to 'Isle of Man Government'
- Debit Card - (only 'in person' applications at the Immigration Service)
- Cash - (only 'in person' applications at the Immigration Service)

## Who should apply using this form?

This form should be completed for child applicants who are 18 or under, who are making an application at a different time to their parent/guardian, and whose original grant of entry was as the **family member** of a British citizen or person present and settled in the Isle of Man.

If the applicant was originally granted entry as a **partner** of a settled person or British Citizen, then the SET (M) form should be completed instead of this one.

If you are now 18 or over, or your original grant of entry was as in any category then you should apply using the Set (O) form.

## Fees notes

### Consideration process

If the payment submitted does not cover the full cost of your application, it will be an invalid application and the form, together with any documentation submitted, will be returned to you.

**The fee charged is for the processing and consideration of the application.** This fee will be payable once the application is received by the Isle of Man Immigration Service, regardless of the outcome of the application.

We cannot begin the consideration process until the payment has cleared. We allow 5 business days for payments made by cheque to clear, debit cards and postal orders will clear immediately.

Should the application be withdrawn at any time during the consideration process the fee will not be refunded.
