Smart travel cards branded as Go cards are being phased in for bus and rail journeys with Isle of Man Transport

## GO SCHOOL

CARDS AVAILABLE FROM 8 DECEMBER 2014



For children using school services to attend Government-run primary (SCH1) and secondary (SCH2) schools and IoM College (SCH3)

**Restrictions:** SCH1/ SCH2 – up to 1800hrs on school days.

SCH3 – up to 2130hrs on college days for full time students aged 16-19 years.

- Bus fares will be reintroduced on all school bus services from 7 January 2015.
- Go School cards will enable students to travel for 25p per journey on school days - providing the smart card and journeys are purchased in advance of travel. Standard fares will apply without a Go School card.
- Cards must be held up to the electronic ticket machine on the bus and the 25p fare will be deducted automatically.
- Parents will be able to register the card and top-up the cards online.
- Children requiring to change buses will be charged only once going to or from school.
- Go School cards will be accepted on all buses serving the Isle of Man College of Further & Higher Education and all schools run by the Department of Education and Children.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Go School cards will not be accepted as proof of age to obtain half fares outside of school journeys. All journeys within the time limits can be taken as school journeys.

## HOW TO BUY YOUR GO SCHOOL CARD

### ONLINE

Follow the link to our online Go card shop from [www.iombusandrail.info](http://www.iombusandrail.info)

Select **Choose Your Go Card** and follow the instructions.

Cards can take up to 5 days to be delivered to your home.



### IN PERSON

Purchase from the Welcome Centre at the Sea Terminal in Douglas, Ramsey Bus Station or Port Erin Station.

You can then go online to register your card and make top-ups online. Alternatively top-ups can be made in person at card issuing stations or the Welcome Centre.

Please allow up to 24 hours for online top-ups to be available for collection on the bus.

**Please note:** two or more children attending the same school can share the same card - multiple journeys can be deducted by holding the card up to the electronic ticket machine after a 5 second gap. A green light will display on the driver's screen to indicate payment has been taken.

Cards will be issued within 5 working days.

On receipt you can register your card and make top-ups online when needed.
