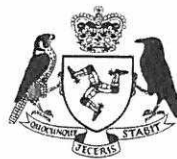

## ONLINE GAMBLING (EXCLUSIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014

*Laid before Tynwald:* 15 July 2014  
*Coming into Operation:* 24 July 2014

The Treasury makes the following Regulations under sections 3(1)(f) and (2) and 21(1)(a) of the Online Gambling Regulation Act 2001.

### 1 Title

These Regulations are the Online Gambling (Exclusions) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.

### 2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 24 July 2014.

### 3 Schedule 1 to the Online Gambling (Exclusion) Regulations 2010<sup>1</sup> amended

At the end of Schedule 1 to the Online Gambling (Exclusion) Regulations 2010, add —

**12.** *Upload and modifier servers*

The deployment in the Island of a machine that, by the use of telecommunications, uploads or modifies games or does both.

**13.** *Tournament facilitators*

The deployment in the Island of a machine that, by the use of telecommunications, allows communications between machines to facilitate tournaments, being interaction between two or more players using two or more machines. **13.**

4 **Schedule 2 to the Online Gambling (Exclusion) Regulations 2010 amended**

At the end of Schedule 2 to the Online Gambling (Exclusion) Regulations 2010, add –

5. An activity specified in paragraph 13 of Schedule 1

No more than two players may participate in tournaments facilitated by the activity in the same premises. 52

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend Schedules 1 and 2 to the Online Gambling (Exclusion) Regulations 2010 to exclude two further activities from being treated as online gambling. These activities cover the uploading or modifying of games for land-based machines such as those found in pubs and clubs and the holding of tournaments – games played between players on different gaming machines.
