Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984

CONTROLLED MACHINES (PRESCRIBED AMOUNTS AND PERCENTAGES) REGULATIONS 2014

Approved by Tynwald: 16 July 2014
Coming into Operation: 24 July 2014

The Isle of Man Gambling Supervision Commission makes the following Regulations under sections 1(4) and (5) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984.¹

1 Title

These Regulations are the Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts and Percentages) Regulations 2014.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 24 July 2014.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations —

“**Act**” means the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984; and

“**quiz machine**” means a prize machine designed or adapted for the playing of a game —

- (a) the only or main object of which is to test the player’s general knowledge; and
- (b) in which there is no element of chance other than the selection of questions put to the player.

4 Prescribed amounts and percentages

(1) The amounts prescribed for the purpose of section 1(4)(a) of the Act (maximum charge for play) are —

- (a) in the case of a quiz machine, £1; and

(b) in any other case, £2.

(2) The amounts prescribed for the purpose of section 1(4)(b) of the Act (maximum prize) are —

(a) in the case of a quiz machine, £50; and

(b) in any other case, £100.

(3) The percentages prescribed for the purpose of section 1(4)(d) of the Act (minimum prize payment) are —

(a) in the case of a quiz machine, 30%; and

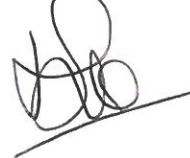
(b) in any other case, 75%.

5 Revocation

(1) Regulation 3 of the Controlled Machines Regulations 1985² is revoked.

(2) The Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) (No. 2) Regulations 2009³ are revoked.
